



The Regional History Room at Bennington Museum is open Monday, Thursday, and Friday afternoons, 1-4pm (by appointment when the Museum is closed January - March email [library@benningtonmuseum.org](mailto:library@benningtonmuseum.org)).

The library collection which is managed by the **Bennington Historical Society**, a program of the Bennington Museum, is the region's most comprehensive resource on the history of Vermont and genealogy of New England and Vermont families. It includes resources not found online such as rare books, family history files, maps, newspapers, and archival resources in the Museum's collection.

The Regional History Room is staffed by knowledgeable volunteers who will be happy to help you with your Bennington-related research. The library is non-circulating and access is free.

Financial support for the refurbishment of the Regional History Room was provided by NSCDA-VT in 1961 and ongoing support is given yearly.
